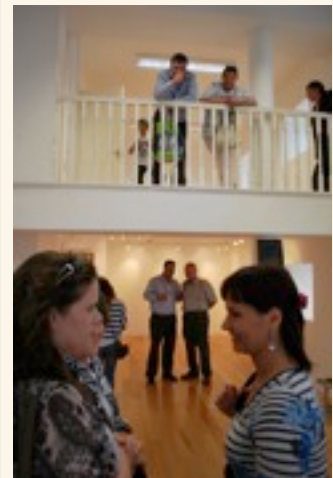

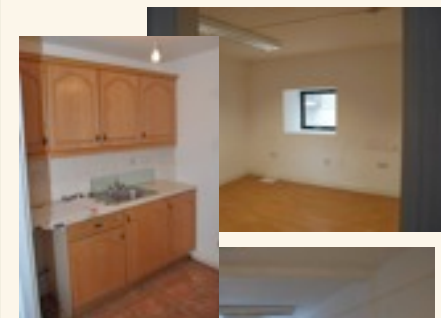
A Closer Look
